PARENT/STUDENT ELECTRONIC RELEASE FORM

I understand and will abide by the *Authorization for Electronic Network Access*. I understand that the District and/or its agents may access and monitor my use of the Internet, including E-mail and download material, without prior notice to me. I further understand that should I commit any violation, my access privileges may be revoked, and school disciplinary action and/or appropriate legal action may be taken. In consideration for using the District's electronic network connection and having access to public networks, I hereby release the School District and its Board members, employees, and agents, from any claims and damages arising from my use of, or inability to use the District's computers, electronic network, and the Internet. For parents, we recommend going over the Prophetstown-Lyndon-Tampico #3 Board Policy on Electronic Network Access with your student to make sure he/she understands his/her responsibilities.

I have read the *Authorization for Electronic Network Access*. I understand that access is designed for educational purposes and that the District has taken precautions to eliminate controversial material. However, I also recognize it is impossible for the District to restrict access to all controversial and inappropriate materials. I will hold harmless the District, its employees, agents, or Board members, for any harm caused by materials or software obtained via the network. I accept full responsibility for supervision if and when my child's use is not in a school setting. I have discussed the terms of this *Authorization* with my child. I request that my child be allowed access to the District's electronic equipment, network and the Internet.

The District retains the option to charge for the time and/or materials to repair or correct the damage, remove software, delete unauthorized files or other costs incurred due to misuse of the computer and Internet privileges. The District also retains the option to charge for the time of Prophetstown-Lyndon-Tampico #3 staff to investigate, document, and correct such misuse.

Prophetstown-Lyndon-Tampico CUSD #3 is now able to publish information on the Internet through web servers in our district. We have set up web pages on the Regional Office of Education's web server also. As a result of this technological progress in our district, we will be publishing more teacher and student projects on our servers, which may be accessible to the World Wide Web. The kind of work published will include, but not be limited to: reports, news items which may include photographs of students, creative writing, artwork, PowerPoint, and Hyperstudio presentations, multimedia projects, and audio/video productions.

Only students' first names will be used. (If more than one student has the same first name, the last initial will be included.) No further information will be published about the student.

If your child's work is chosen for publication on the Web, newspaper or other print media, or broadcast media (radio or television), your signature on this form acknowledges your permission for his/her work to be published on the Prophetstown-Lyndon-Tampico #3 home pages or in newspaper articles (i.e., Kids Tech Talk).

My child's work, which will be accompanied by the first name or initials, may be displayed electronically or in print and produced by Prophetstown-Lyndon-Tampico #3.
